

# Harnessing AI for Safe Trade in Latin America and the Caribbean

## “Innovations for SPS Transformation”

(24 -26 November 2025)

San José, Costa Rica

### Background and Rationale

The Inter-American Institute for Cooperation on Agriculture (IICA) and the Standards and Trade Development Facility (STDF) partner to pilot innovations to strengthen sanitary and phytosanitary (SPS) capacity at national, regional and global levels and facilitate safe trade.

Innovation in SPS development refers to the introduction and application of new or improved tools, technologies, practices, or approaches that enhance the effectiveness, efficiency, and inclusiveness of SPS systems. These innovations help countries meet international standards (Codex, IPPC and WOH) to protect human, animal and plant health, and facilitate safe trade.

In line with IICA and STDF strategies this event will be organized in the Americas in November 2025. Americas are a fitting starting point given its dynamic SPS landscape and regional integration, as well as pioneering use of new technologies, artificial intelligence (AI) and other types of innovative approaches and practices.

The event in Latin America and the Caribbean will build on previous work (including the Vienna Food Safety Forum in June 2025), share experiences from relevant STDF-funded projects, and learn from other work supported by IICA and sub-regional organizations, as well as STDF partners and national governments, in the region.

### Objectives of the event

- Highlight innovative SPS solutions, including those supported by IICA and STDF in the Americas, with potential for scaling while fostering regional dialogue on the following:
  - Challenges and opportunities of using AI on epidemiological models
  - Adoption of AI for import risk assessments
  - Implementation of AI models for animal movement and traceability systems
  - AI use to inform risk-based border controls, sampling and inspection
  - Using AI on big data to determine risk profiles and audit routines
  - Implementation of AI applied to large databases to expedite evaluation processes.
  - Financing to roll out and scale AI-based SPS solutions for safe trade facilitation

- Strengthen links and cooperation among Member States and International Organizations to support the achievement of IICA and STDF's outcomes and programme goals.

### Format of the event

In-person event on 24-26 November 2025 at IICA's Headquarters in Costa Rica.
